09:10-09:40 AM	<p><b>Introducing UNCRD's EST Initiative, Objectives of the Regional EST Forum, Aichi Statement</b></p> <p>[UNCRD has launched an initiative to promote environmentally sustainable transport (EST) in Asia, in line with the decisions taken at "the Manila Policy Dialogue on Environment &amp; Transport in the Asian Region", in Manila, Philippines, 16-17 January 2004. The Manila Statement adopted at the conference urged Asian countries to (a) formulate National EST Strategies-cum-Action-Plans, and to (b) establish the Regional EST Forum in Asia and subsidiary EST expert groups. As a follow up to these outcomes, the First Meeting of the Regional EST Forum in Asia was held on 1-2 August 2005 in Nagoya, Japan. In the meeting, the Aichi Statement was adopted which officially launched the Regional EST Forum in Asia and set a concrete future vision for the regional promotion of EST.
