Why do we need a web site?

- Too many "islands" of information of various quality
- No single web site (yet) that brings together information on mobile sources of air pollution in Asia
- No commonly accepted structure, making information difficult to find

- Database of policies, standards and actions (repository and portal)
- Vehicle and fuel information
- Strategies for reducing vehicle emissions

- Navbar must always be on the right
- Site must be designed for 640x480 resolution monitors
- Site must be backward compatible with Internet Explorer 4.0 and Netscape 4.0

- Cooperation agreements with other sites (e.g. APMA, JARI)
