1. Public transport
2. non-motorised transport and public space improvements

Terms of Reference of the Working Groups:

Objective:

Analysis of the working group issue and elaboration of framework guidelines/work programme for improvements

Tasks:

- Critical analysis of the present planning and implementation process, in order to understand the current problems
- Possible policy measures for sustainable urban transport (options and alternatives) and strategic interventions
- Stakeholder analysis (“who would be in favour - who against measures”)
- Next steps and possible priority areas for cities
(What are the major steps to assess and analyse problem areas and recommend and implement required action)
