Fort Collins, CO – Envirofit International Ltd., a Colorado non-profit corporation developing and commercializing environmentally friendly and energy efficient technologies in Asia, today announced that it has been selected by The Tech Museum Awards (San Jose, CA) as one of its five 2005 Intel Environmental Laureates.

The Tech Museum Awards ([www.techawards.org](http://www.techawards.org)) honor individuals, for-profit, public and not-for-profit organizations from around the world who apply technology to profoundly improve the human condition in the areas of environment, economic development, education, equality and health. The Tech Museum Awards were inaugurated in 2001. To date, \$1 million in prize money has been disbursed and 100 Laureates recognized for their pioneering work to benefit society through the use and/or development of new technologies. This year the Tech Museum Awards received over 580 nominations representing eighty countries. At a black-tie gala attended by over 1,100 Silicon Valley technology leaders, philanthropists and guests, Envirofit was honored for its technological contribution to the betterment of people and society in Asia, and in particular for its direct-injection two-stroke engine retrofit program in the city of Vigan in the Philippine province of Ilocos Sur. This project will reduce annual carbon dioxide emissions by over 3,300 tons, and will reduce annual fuel consumption by over 400,000 gallons. “It’s a tremendous honor,” said Envirofit CEO Brock Silvers, “to be included in such an accomplished global group of social entrepreneurs. It speaks to Envirofit’s success, and makes us even more firmly committed to our goals.”

Also, Envirofit announced today that it has added two new members to its Board of Directors: Mr. Brock Silvers and Mr. Ronald Bills. Mr. Silvers currently serves as the Chief Executive Officer of Envirofit, and formerly served as a Partner in the China-based investment firm of Power Pacific Company. Mr. Bills formerly served as the President/CEO of Segway LLC (Bedford, New Hampshire), a developer and manufacturer of high technology alternative fuel transportation technology and products. Said Mr. Silvers, “I believe that Mr. Bills and I are joining the Envirofit Board at a very exciting time, just as the company establishes significant commercial operations in Asia. The overall depth of Envirofit’s Board should help to make those operations a great success.”
