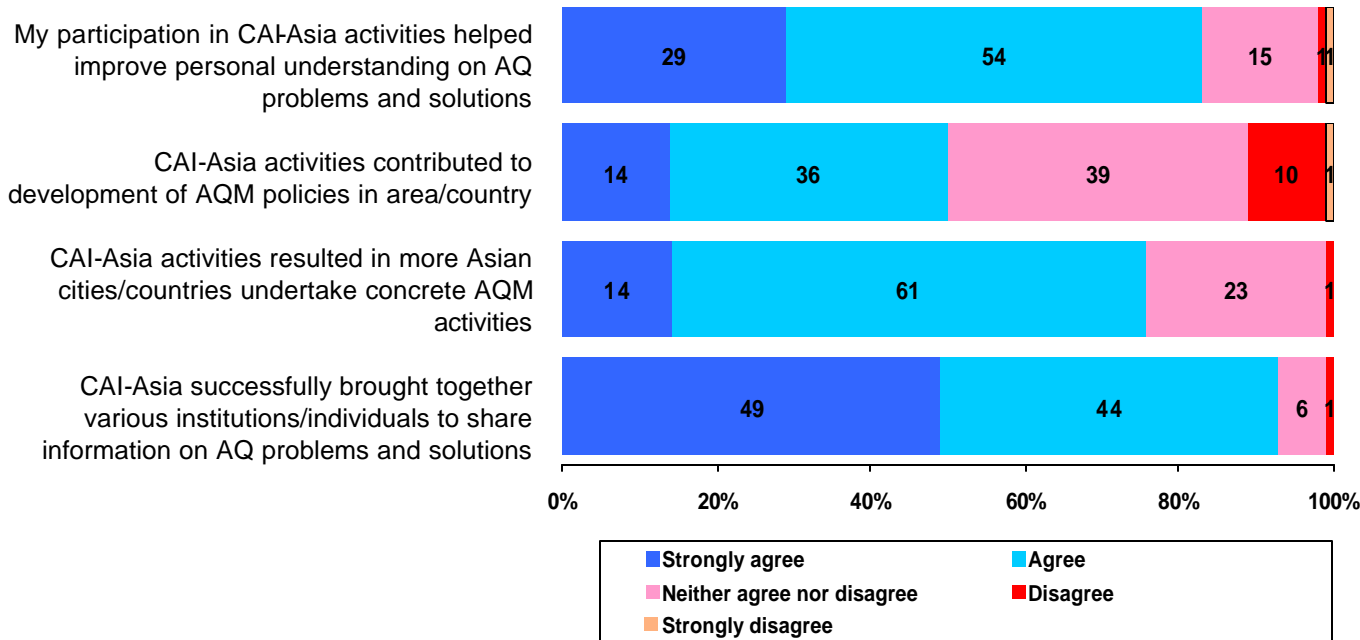

- **CAI Asia has been very effective in promoting understanding of AQ and bringing together various institutions / individuals to share information on AQ problems and solutions.**
- **Moreover, it has also influenced cities / countries to undertake concrete AQM activities and to a lesser extent, contributed to the development of AQM policies.**

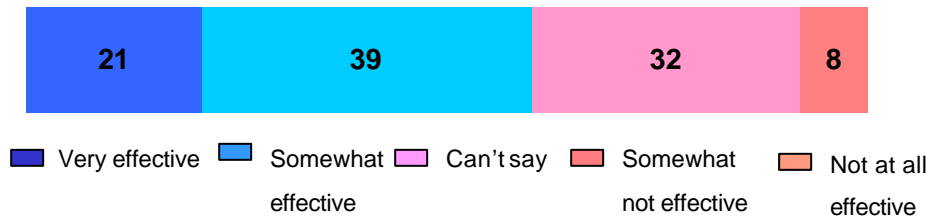

Regional Dialogue

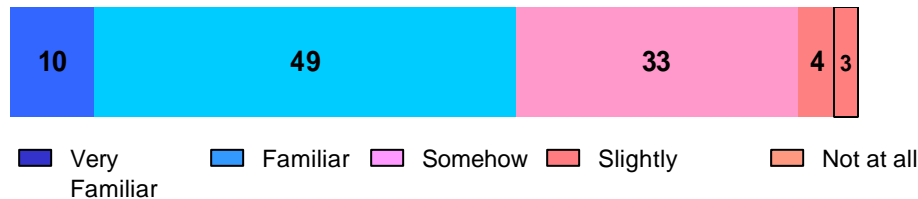

- Majority perceive CAI-Asia as effective in promoting cooperation in Asia.
- Although about half are familiar with the strategic framework, there is still potential to increase awareness on this, particularly among non-members.
- About six out of 10 survey participants claim that APMA and CAI-Asia’s strategic framework helped them in their work.

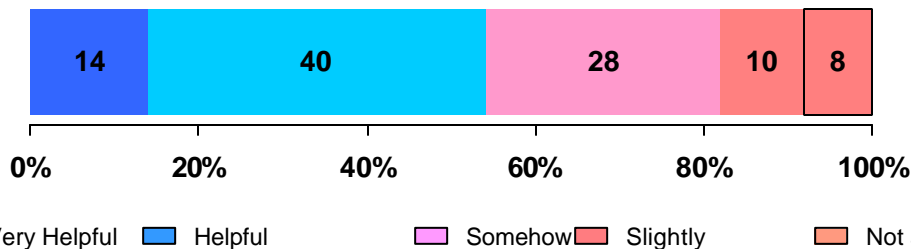
Q16. “In your opinion, how effective has CAI-Asia been in coordinating and promoting cooperation on AQ-related activities in Asia?”
